Major Issues Discussed

- 1. Chairman Reisinger called the hearing to order, read the bill number and purpose, and confirmed that the public notice requirements were met.

- 3. Matthew DeSantis explained that the Planning Commission would hear the bill on November 12 and that the Planning Staff are concerned that there may not be facts sufficient to support a finding of mistake in the existing zoning or a significant change in the area. He and Eric Tiso also responded to committee member questions concerning zoning for churches in general.

- 6. Joseph Woolman discussed facts supporting the required findings to rezone the property.
