AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING

City Streets – Opening – A 13-Foot Alley

- FOR the purpose of condemning and opening a 13-foot alley, extending from East Biddle Street
 Northerly 80 feet, to a 20-foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties known as nos. 2000
 through 2030 East Biddle Street, as shown on Plat 314-B-16 in the Office of the Department
 of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the 16 Department of Transportation shall proceed to condemn and open a 13-foot alley, extending from 17 East Biddle Street Northerly 80 feet, to a 20-foot alley laid out in the rear of the properties known 18 as nos. 2000 through 2030 East Biddle Street, and more particularly described as follows:

19 Beginning for Parcel 1 at the point formed by the intersection of the east side of a 13-foot alley and the north side of East Biddle Street 66 feet wide, the point of 20 21 beginning being distant 194 feet measured along the north side of East Biddle Street from the intersection of North Chester Street 60 feet wide, and the north 22 side of East Biddle Street; thence binding on the north side of East Biddle Street 23 Westerly 13 feet to the west side of a 13-foot alley; thence binding on the west 24 side of the 13-foot alley Northerly 80 feet to intersect the south side of a 20-foot 25 alley; thence binding on the south side of the 20-foot alley Easterly 21.9 feet, 26 27 more or less, to the easternmost extremity of the 20 foot-alley; thence leaving the 28 easternmost extremity of the 20-foot alley Southwesterly 13.4 feet, more or less,

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the proceedings for the condemnation and
 opening of the 13-foot alley and the rights of all interested parties shall be regulated by and in
 accordance with all applicable provisions of state and local law and with all applicable rules and
 regulations adopted by the Director of Transportation and filed with the Department of
 Legislative Reference.
