INTRODUCTION

The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) is reporting on City Council Bill No. 20-0548 introduced by President Scott, Councilmembers Pinkett, Burnett, Clarke, Reisinger, Dorsey, Middleton, Stokes.

PURPOSE

For the purpose of designating the Reed Calloway House, 1316 North Carey Street, as an historical landmark: exterior.

BRIEF HISTORY

Per the CHAP staff report, adding the property to the landmark list will protect the building that has been identified as one of three surviving properties associated with Cab and Blanche Calloway in Baltimore. The property is also associated with the Reed Family, who made many contributions to the City's civic, educational, and religious life.
