BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in accordance with Article V, § 5(b) of the City Charter, the City Comptroller may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in a certain parcel of land known as the former bed of a 10-foot alley bounded by Etting Street, a variable width alley, West Lafayette Avenue, and West Lanvale Street, and more particularly described as follows:
- Beginning for Parcel No. 1 at the point formed by the intersection of the 17 southwest side of Etting Street, 20 feet wide, and the northwest side of a 10-foot 18 19 alley, the point of beginning being distant Southeasterly 109 feet, more or less, measured along the southwest side of Etting Street from the southeast side of 20 West Lafayette Avenue, 66 feet wide; thence binding on the southeast side of 21 Etting Street, Southeasterly 10 feet, more or less, to the southeast corner of the 10-22 foot alley; thence binding on the east side of the 10-foot alley, Southwesterly 60 23 feet, more or less, to the intersection of the northeast side of a variable width 24 25 alley; thence binding on the variable width alley, Northwesterly 10 feet, more or 26 less, to the southwest corner of the 10-foot alley; and thence binding on the west 27 side of the 10-foot alley, Northeasterly 60 feet, more or less, to the place of
