Major Issues Discussed

- 1. Councilwoman Middleton opened the meeting, introduced committee members and City representative. She read the bill into the record.
- 2. Councilmember Stokes commented on the bill emphasizing that the bill would not impact people who already have lease agreements.
- 3. Ms. Nikki Thompson presented amendments to:
 - Define the term "Government Benefit"
 - Emphasize that the bill does not apply to leases for HABC public housing
 - Add new language requiring that leases that include penalties for late payment of rent MUST also include a provision prohibiting the landlord from applying a penalty for late payment of rent until:
 - the tenant's payment of rent is more than 10 days late, OR
 - the tenant has received their regular scheduled government benefit disbursement (if the tenant has previously provided the landlord with written notice showing the day of the month the benefit is normally issued or mailed is later than the day on which the rent is due).
