## **Major Issues Discussed**

- 1. Councilwoman Middleton opened the meeting, introduced committee members and City representatives. She read the bill into the record.
- 2. Councilmember James Torrence, sponsor, explained the purpose of the bill.
- 3. Mr. Nicholas Blendy provided general information about the change in State law that created Class A-7 liquor licenses, which will allow businesses to open from 10:00 a.m. 12:00 midnight 7 days/week. There are, however, certain districts in Baltimore City that may have different, more restrictive hours of operation as required by the State. He testified in support of his agency's report.
- 4. Representatives from other City agencies confirmed recommendations specified in their agencies' written reports.
- 5. The committee voted to recommend the bill favorably.
- 6. The hearing was adjourned.
