

Background

The Office of the City Administrator has been requested to review City Council Bill # 21-0044, Retirement Boards – Composition. Council Bill # 21-0044 allows the Board of Trustees for the Retirement Savings Plan and Fire and Police Employees’ Retirement to allow the Comptroller to designate the Deputy Comptroller to act in place of the Comptroller. Bill # 21-0044 additionally corrects related provisions and provides the date for which this Bill will become effective.
