1 AN ORDINANCE concerning

2 **Zoning – Conditional Use Retail Goods Establishment (With Alcoholic Beverages Sales) –**
3 **A Portion of 3901 Boston Street (Also Known As 3975 Boston Street)**

4 FOR the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and
5 operation of a retail goods establishment (with alcoholic beverages sales) on the property
6 known as 3901 Boston Street (also known as 3975 Boston Street), as outlined in red on the
7 accompanying plat; and providing for a special effective date.

13 **SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE,** That
14 permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a retail goods
15 establishment (with alcoholic beverages sales) on the property known as 3901 Boston Street
16 (also known as 3975 Boston Street), as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance,
17 in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 5-201(a), 14-336 and *Table 10-301 (C-3)*,
18 subject to the condition that the retail goods establishment (with alcoholic beverages sales)
19 complies with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate matter added to existing law.
[Brackets] indicate matter deleted from existing law.

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1 **SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That as evidence of the authenticity of the
2 accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning
3 Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council
4 shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat;
5 and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the
6 Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of
7 Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and
8 the Zoning Administrator.

9 **SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is
10 enacted.
