- 1. Councilwoman Middleton opened the meeting, introduced committee members and City representatives, and read the bill into the record.
- 2. Ms. Bruna Attila reported on the bill and gave a presentation about the City's Floodplain Management Plan and National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP).
- 3. Representatives from City agencies confirmed the recommendations in the agencies' written reports. For the City to maintain participation in the NFIP, the bill must be approved by June 16, 2021. One benefit of participation in the program is 10% -25% discount for insurance.
- 4. The committee discussed golf courses and recreational facilities in floodways.
- 5. The committee approved an amendment for the bill.
- 6. The committee voted to recommend the bill favorable with an amendment.
- 7. The hearing was adjourned.
