<u>INTRODUCTION</u> – Rezoning - 605 South Caton Avenue

<u>PURPOSE/PLANS</u> – For the purpose of changing the zoning for the property known as 605 South Caton Avenue, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat, from the C-2 Zoning District to the I-2 Zoning District; and providing for a special effective date.

<u>COMMENTS</u> – Council Bill 21-0054 looks to 605 South Caton Avenue from the C-2 Zoning District to the I-2 Zoning District. Per the City's Zoning Code, C-2 Zoning Districts permit small to medium-scale commercial establishments. I-2 Zoning Districts allow for general industrial uses, including warehousing, manufacturing, and open storage. The legislation's statement of intent states the proposed rezoning would allow the property owner to continue existing use of the parcel for construction equipment and material storage.
