Major Issues Discussed

- 1. Councilwoman Middleton opened the meeting, introduced committee members and read the bill into the record.
- 2. Scott Brillman explained the purpose of the bill. He provided background information about Kari's Law and Baltimore City's effort to comply with the law. All multi-telephone systems must allow for dialing 9-1-1 without having to dial any other number.
- 3. Agency representatives provided reports for their respective agencies. All agencies supported the bill.
- 4. Councilmember Ramos asked if compliance is required for all of Maryland State jurisdictions. Mr. Brillman explained that all jurisdictions can follow the process for implementation of the law. According to the bill, when fire marshals inspect City buildings for compliance with Kari's Law, the findings will be reported to the State.
- 5. The committee voted to recommend the bill favorably.
- 6. The hearing was adjourned.
