INTRODUCTION

The Baltimore Development Corporation (BDC) is reporting on City Council Bill No. 21-0090 introduced by the Council President at the request of the Administration.

PURPOSE

For the purpose of condemning and closing of Etting Street and four ten-foot alleys bounded by Druid Hill Avenue, Gold Street, Division Street and Baker Street as shown on a plat numbered 337-A-28A and filed in the Office of the Department of Transportation; and providing for a special effective date.

BRIEF HISTORY

This Bill will provide for the creation of a new community asset in the form of open space known as Cab Calloway Legends Park.
