INTRODUCTION – Street Encroachment - 1707 Eastern Avenue

PURPOSE/PLANS – For the purpose of permitting, subject to certain conditions, the construction and maintenance of a portion of a building projecting into the public right-of-way on the south side of Eastern Avenue, on the property known as 1707 Eastern Avenue.

COMMENTS – Council Bill 21-0071 looks to permit encroachment on public right-of-way in the south side of Eastern Avenue, at 1707 Eastern Avenue. A licensed professional surveyor found the existing encroachment extending approximately 1.6 feet into public right-of-way. When notified of encroachment, it is DOT policy to enter into a right of entry agreement and then execute an encroachment ordinance.
