INTRODUCTION – Sale of Property - Block 6997, Lot 002

PURPOSE/PLANS – For the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain property located at NES Broening Highway 844-1 ft. SE of Colgate Creek (Block 6997, Lot 002) and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

COMMENTS – Council Bill 21-0091 seeks authorization allowing the sale of City-owned property, specifically Block 6997, Lot 002, adjacent the Port of Baltimore.
