13	Recitals
14	The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Coronavirus Aid,
15	Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES") in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of
16	Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2021.
17	This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of
18	Estimates for Fiscal Year 2021 was formulated.
19	This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
20	Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2021 was formulated or is for a new program that could
21	not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.
22	On September 15, 2021, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
23	Council.

## Council Bill 21-0130

**SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That \$8,933,951.06 shall be made available to the Health Department – Service 315 (Emergency Services - Health) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2021, to provide funding for pandemic response personnel, contact tracing, and testing expenses resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic. The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds from CARES in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2021.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is 9 enacted.
