1 AN ORDINANCE concerning **Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation –** 2 **Health Department – \$15,200,000** 3 FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the 4 5 amount of \$15,200,000 to the Health Department – Service 315 (Emergency Services -Health), to provide funding for hotel sheltering expenses resulting from the COVID-19 6 pandemic; and providing for a special effective date. By authority of 8 9 Article VI - Board of Estimates Section 8(b)(3) and (c)10 **Baltimore City Charter** 11 (1996 Edition) 12 13 Recitals The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Transfer Tax in excess 14 of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance 15 the budget for Fiscal Year 2021. 16 17 This additional revenue could not have been reasonably anticipated when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2021 was formulated. 18 19 This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2021 was formulated or is for a new program that could 20 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated. 21 22 On September 15, 2021, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City Council. 23

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That
\$15,200,000 shall be made available to the Health Department – Service 315 (Emergency
Services - Health) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year
2021, to provide funding for hotel sheltering expenses resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic.
The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds from the Transfer Tax in excess of the
amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy
required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2021.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
