Recitals

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents funds from the Coronavirus Aid,
 Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES") in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of
 Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2021.

This appropriation is made necessary by a material change in circumstances since the
 Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2021 was formulated or is for a new program that could
 not have been reasonably anticipated when that Ordinance of Estimates was formulated.

On September 15, 2021, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City
 Council.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That 1 \$7,383,249 shall be made available to the M-R: Office of Children and Family Success - Service 2 109 (Administration - Children and Family Success) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating 3 Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2021, to provide funding for the Eviction Prevention Program to 4 pay landlords for delinquent accounts and avoid tenant evictions resulting from the COVID-19 5 pandemic. The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds from CARES in excess of the 6 amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy 7 8 required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2021.
