The Baltimore City Health Department (BCHD) is pleased to have the opportunity to review City Council bill #21-0132, entitled "Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation – Department of Health \$15,200,000." This legislation seeks to provide a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation in the amount of \$15,200,000 to the Department of Health – Service 315 (Emergency Services - Health).

The BCHD incurred expenditures resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic, including hotel sheltering expenses. This appropriation is required to bring our FY21 budget into balance, and is necessary due to the increased costs related to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. Revenue from the Transfer Tax will be used to cover these supplemental expenses.
