## **Major Issues Discussed**

- 1. One major issue discussed was the attrition rate at the Baltimore City Police Department. Many experienced offiers are opting to either retire or seek employment at other law enforcement agencies in the DMV area.
- 2. A councilmember questioned the staffing make-up of the Consent Decree Monitoring Team and the dollar amount the City pays each year for the work the committee is doing. It was mentioned by a member of the committee that they employ about 25 people and that number includes the members of the Consent Decree Committee.
- 3. A question arosed regarding the staffing shortage within the BPD and what is the plan in place to deal with the shortage of officers particularly as the department is experiencing problems with recruiting applicants to join the force.
- 4. It was pointed out that the Consent Decree Monitoring Team has been working diligently to ensure revised policies and procedures regarding the "stop and frisk" is no longer a tool officers can use to stop and search citizens without legal justification.
- 5. The committee stated that a review of BPD's investigations revealed that they were poorly executed and files were in poor condition. The Consent Decree Committee has made tremendous improvements in area of investigations.
- 6. It was mentioned by the Consent Decree Committee that the Public Integrity Bureau will be evaluated this year.
- 7. New strategies and skills are being developed to deal with citizens who have physical and mental challenges. The policy revisions are due in part to community input and participation.
- 8. The Committee will draft a final report at the end of its work.
- 9. The Committee of the Whole is now in recess.
