Major Issues Discussed

- 1. Councilmember Middleton read the bill into the record and introduced councilmembers in attendance.
- 2. Councilmember Bullock explained the purpose of the bill.
- 3. Matt DeSantis commented about the purpose of the bill and explained a proposed amendment which would remove the applicant's request for variance determined not to be needed. He explained the findings approved by the Planning Commission.
- 4. Hilary Ruley provided the Law Department's report which approved the bill for form and legal sufficiency. She also clarified protocol for handling approval of findings of fact.
- 5. Agency representatives provided reports for their respective agencies.
- 6. A question was asked about whether authorization for a street encroachment would be required. Planning staff discussed that the internal design of the building does not expand beyond the existing structure of the building.
- 7. The committee opened the hearing for public testimony.
- 8. The committee approved the amendment.
- 9. Based on the findings, the committee approved a motion to recommend the bill favorably with an amendment.
- 10. The hearing was adjourned.
