#### **Major Issues Discussed**

- 1. Councilmember Middleton read the bill into the record and introduced councilmembers in attendance.
- 2. Councilmember Torrence commented about the purpose of the bill and answered questions about the requested zoning change.
- 3. Matt DeSantis commented about the purpose of the bill and explained the findings approved by the Planning Commission. The Planning Commission found that a mistake was made for the current zoning and that there had been a change in the character of the neighborhood via the City's flood map.
- 4. Elena DiPietro provided the Law Department's report which approved the bill for form and legal sufficiency.
- 5. Agency representatives provided reports for their respective agencies.
- 6. The committee opened the hearing for public testimony.
- 7. Al Barry testified in support of the bill. He also explained the applicant's request for IMU-2 zoning for the property.
- 8. Based on the findings, the committee approved a motion to recommend the bill favorably.
