4 2021, to provide funding for pandemic response personnel, contact tracing, and testing expenses

5 resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic. The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds

6 from CARES in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of

7 Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2021.
