BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE**, That \$5,107,420 shall be made available to the Department of Planning – Service 765 (Planning for a Sustainable Baltimore) as a Supplementary General Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2021, to provide funding for food security program expenses resulting from the COVID-19 pandemic. The source of revenue for this appropriation is funds from FEMA in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2021.
