Major Issues Discussed

- 1. The chairman thanked the Mayor for his participation in extending the tax credit and for moving forward with economic development. He also briefly talked about the new task force that Mayor Scott is creating to evaluate Baltimore City's existing tax credits.
- 2. Per the Budget Director, the new workgroup/task force must take an honest/critical look at the city's tax credits and come back to the table with some opportunity for improvements.
- 3. Committee member Dorsey asked the Budget Director if he could share any information established from working with the group. Answer: No, not yet. Member Dorsey also stated that he is concerned overall about this particular tax credit in general and is looking forward to seeing more about this credit. Requested by Dorsey: Please submit information as soon as it is available.
- 4. Five (5) speakers gave public testimony; all in support of the bill/tax credit. Some highlighted comments were:
 - o This ordinance is an important issue, the bill will help support the initiatives of the new task force
 - We need help getting projects completed
 - Our company continues to invest in downtown Baltimore and in city neighborhoods
 - Has served on several task forces regarding tax credit issues and some tax credits are impediments
- 5. Chairman Costello talked about his proposed amendments. Vote taken on amendments. Vote taken on bill: passed Favorable with Amendments. Hearing concluded.
