7	the R-8 Zoning District on the property known as 1049 Brantley Avenue (Block 0115, Lot 069),		
8	as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City		
9	Zoning Code §§ 5-201(a) and 9-701(2), subject to the condition that the building complies with		
0.0	all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.		
.1	SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That pursuant to the authority granted by §§ 5-		
2	305(a) and 5-308 of Article 32 - Zoning, permission is granted from the requirements of § 9-401		
13	(Table 9-401: Rowhouse and Multi-Family Residential Districts - Bulk and Yard Regulations), a		
4	the minimum lot size requirement for 2 dwelling units, in the R-8 Zoning District, is 1,500		
15	square feet, and the lot area size is approximately 1.050 square feet.

4	Parking) for off-street parking.
5	SECTION 3 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the
6	accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning
7	Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council
8	shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat;
9	and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the
10	Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of
11	Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and
12	the Zoning Administrator.
13	SECTION 45. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th
14	day after the date it is enacted.




