Major Issues Discussed

- 1. Chairwoman Middleton opened the meeting, introduced committee members and City representatives and read the bill into the record.
- 2. Agency representatives testified on behalf of their respective agencies. Liam Davis stated that the franchise agreement would be for 25 years and that the Department of Transportation (DOT) would like to waive the franchise fee, for the State of Maryland, but if the Board of Estimates decided not to waive the fee then DOT's recommendation would be for an annual fee of \$3,380. He presented a proposed technical amendment to correct the number of the Developer's Agreement.
- 3. The bill will be referred to the Board of Estimates.
- 4. The committee voted to approve the amendment.
- 6. The committee voted to recommend the bill favorably with amendment.
- 7. The hearing was adjourned.
