A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning

Supplementary Federal Fund Appropriation - Department of General Services - \$190,500

FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary Federal Fund Appropriation in the amount of \$190,500 to the Department of General Services (Account # 9916-909015-9194), to provide funding to underwrite a collaborative effort between the Department of General Services and the Johns Hopkins University Office of Sustainability to promote energy conservation by Baltimore City nonprofit organizations; and providing for a special effective date.

BY authority of Article VI - Board of Estimates Section 8(b)(2) and (c) Baltimore City Charter (1996 Edition)

Recitals

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Climate Showcase in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.

That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2011 was formulated.

On April 20, 2011, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City Council.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That \$190,500 shall be made available to the Department of General Services (Account # 9916-909015-9194) as a Supplementary Federal Fund Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2011, to provide funding to underwrite a collaborative effort between the Department of General Services and the Johns Hopkins University Office of Sustainability to promote energy conservation by Baltimore City nonprofit organizations. The source of revenue for this appropriation is the grant from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Climate Showcase in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2011.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
