## CITY OF BALTIMORE COUNCIL BILL

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning

Minority and Women's Business Enterprises - Program Extension

FOR the purpose of extending the existence of the City's Minority and Women's Business Enterprises program by 6 months; providing for a special effective date; and generally relating to the participation of minority and woman owned business entities in City contracts.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments Article 5 - Finance, Property, and Procurement Section(s) 28-6 Baltimore City Code (Edition 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 5. Finance, Property, and Procurement

Subtitle 28. Minority and Women's Business Enterprises

§ 2861 Automatic termination.

This subtitle automatically expires on [June 30] DECEMBER 31, 2013, unless the City Council, after causing an appropriate study to be undertaken, conducting public hearings, and hearing testimonial evidence, finds that the purposes identified in this subtitle have not yet been achieved, in which case this subtitle may be extended for 5 more years.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on June 30, 2013.
