**Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore,** That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

### **Baltimore City Code**

#### **Article 32. Zoning**

#### **Title 5. Applications and Authorizations**

#### *Subtitle 5. Legislative Authorizations*

#### **§ 5-507. Action by City Council.**

(a) *Committee hearing.*

- (1) The bill must be considered at a public hearing of a committee of the City Council[, to be held within 90 days of the introduction]. Notice of the public hearing must be given in accordance with Title 5, Subtitle 6 {"Notices"}.

**Section 2. And be it further ordained,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

**Section 3. And be it further ordained,** That this Ordinance takes effect when it is enacted, retroactive to June 5, 2017.
