For the purpose of establishing the boundaries of the Council Districts for the election of members of the Baltimore City Council.

Article III - City Council
Section 7
Baltimore City Charter

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the Council Districts for the election of members of the City Council are as follows:
