Section 1-38(a)

Baltimore City Code

(Edition 2000)

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 31. Transit and Traffic

Subtitle 10. Residential Permit Parking Program

§ 10-38. Guilford Area.

(a) *Area delineated.*

The Guilford Area consists of:

- (1) the unit blocks of St. Martin's Road and East Bishops Road; and
- (2) **3701, 3703, 3705, and 3801 N. Charles Street.**

Section 2. And be it further ordained, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

Section 3. And be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
