AN ORDINANCE concerning  
**Water Regulations - Citation Penalties**

FOR the purpose of reducing the prepayable citation penalties for certain violations of regulations adopted to protect the City's water supply and facilities.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments  
Article 1 - Mayor, City Council, and Municipal Agencies  
Section(s) 40-14(e)(4a) and 41-14(3)  
Baltimore City Code  
(Edition 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
