**Section 3.** And be it further resolved, That the Capital Budget of Baltimore City Public School System consists of \$44,807,862 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025. Sources of these funds are \$19,000,000 from City of Baltimore General Obligation Bonds and \$25,807,862 from the State of Maryland.
