Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 28. Taxes

Subtitle 10. Credits

§ 10-8. Historic improvements, restorations, and rehabilitations.

(m) *Termination of program.*

Applications for a credit under this section may not be accepted after [August 28, 2024] December 31, 2027.

Section 2. And be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
