SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation

Subtitle 12. Landmark List - 2000s

§ 12-26. BOLTON SQUARE.

BOLTON SQUARE, 1400 TO 1420 MASON STREET, 300 TO 310 WEST LAFAYETTE AVENUE, 236 TO 250 WEST LAFAYETTE AVENUE, AND 1401 TO 1421 JORDON STREET.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
