City Streets - Renaming South Hilton Street to Unsel'd's Way

FOR the purpose of changing the name of South Hilton Street, between West Caton Avenue and Frederick Road, to Unsel'd's Way.

Article 26 - Surveys, Streets, and Highways
Section 7-3
Baltimore City Code
(Edition 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the name of South Hilton Street, between West Caton Avenue and Frederick Road, is changed to Unsel'd's Way.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
