A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning
**Zoning - Conditional Use Parking, Open Off-Street Area - 5401 Tippett Avenue, 5451 Tippett Avenue, 4033
Lewiston Avenue, and Portions of Rockfield Avenue and Tippett Avenue**

FOR the purpose of repealing Ordinance 65-640 and permitting, subject to certain conditions, the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a parking, open off-street area (including driving test area) on the properties known as 5401 Tippett Avenue, 5451 Tippett Avenue, 4033 Lewiston Avenue, and portions of Rockfield Avenue and Tippett Avenue, as outlined in red on the accompanying plat.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That Ordinance 65-640 is hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That permission is granted for the establishment, maintenance, and operation of a parking, open off-street area (including driving test area) on the properties known as 5401 Tippett Avenue, 5451 Tippett Avenue, 4033 Lewiston Avenue, and portions of Rockfield Avenue and Tippett Avenue, as outlined in red on the plat accompanying this Ordinance, in accordance with Baltimore City Zoning Code §§ 4-904 and 14-102, subject to the condition that the parking, open off-street area (including driving test area) complies with all applicable federal, state, and local licensing and certification requirements.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That as evidence of the authenticity of the accompanying plat and in order to give notice to the agencies that administer the City Zoning Ordinance: (i) when the City Council passes this Ordinance, the President of the City Council shall sign the plat; (ii) when the Mayor approves this

Ordinance, the Mayor shall sign the plat; and (iii) the Director of Finance then shall transmit a copy of this Ordinance and the plat to the Board of Municipal and Zoning Appeals, the Planning Commission, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development, the Supervisor of Assessments for Baltimore City, and the Zoning Administrator.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
