## Tax Credits - Historic Restorations and Rehabilitations

FOR the purpose of extending the period within which applications may be accepted for the tax credit for historic restorations and rehabilitations; and providing for a special effective date.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments

Article 28 - Taxes Section(s) 10-8 Baltimore City Code (Edition 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 28. Taxes

Subtitle 10. Credits

§ 1081 Historic restorations and rehabilitations.

(m) Termination of program.

Applications for the credit may not be accepted after February 28, [2009] 2014.
