A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning
Waterfront Management District - Supplemental Tax

FOR the purpose of providing that property tax credits applicable to the regular, citywide property tax do not apply to the Supplemental Tax imposed in the Waterfront Management District; and providing for a special effective date.

BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 14. Special Benefits Districts

Subtitle 8. Waterfront Management District

§ 88. Supplemental Tax.

(b) Assessment; collection; enforcement.

(3) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle:

- (i) the Supplemental Tax shall be enforced in the same way as the Regular Tax is enforced; and
- (ii) all provisions that apply to assessments, refunds, [credits,] collections, and enforcement of the Regular Tax apply to the Supplemental Tax.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted, applicable to the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2008, and to each subsequent fiscal year.
