**Baltimore City Landmark List - President Street Station**

FOR the purpose of designating the President Street Station, 601 President Street/801 Fleet Street, as a historical landmark.

Article 6 - Historical and Architectural Preservation  
Section(s) 12-33  
Baltimore City Code  
(Edition 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation

Subtitle 12. Landmark List - 2000s

§ 12-33. PRESIDENT STREET STATION.

PRESIDENT STREET STATION, 601 PRESIDENT STREET/801 FLEET STREET.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date

it is enacted.
