For the purpose of designating the Harry O. Wilson House, 4423 Craddock Avenue, as an historical landmark:

**Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore,** That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

**Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation**

**Subtitle 17A. Landmark List: Exteriors - 2010s**

**§ 17A-44. Harry O. Wilson House.**

Harry O. Wilson House, 4423 Craddock Avenue.

**Section 2. And be it further ordained,** That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

**Section 3. And be it further ordained,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30<sup>th</sup> day after the date it is enacted.
