An Ordinance concerning

#### Recyclable Materials and Yard Waste - Disposal

For the purpose of prohibiting the disposal of recyclable materials and yard waste in a landfill or an incinerator; and providing for a special effective date.

By repealing and re-ordaining, with amendments

Article 23 - Sanitation Section 16-1 Baltimore City Code (Edition 2000)

**Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore**, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

#### **Baltimore City Code**

#### **Article 23. Sanitation**

#### Subtitle 16. Recyclable Materials and Compostable Yard Waste

# § 16-1. [No disposal at Quarantine Landfill] Disposal of recyclable materials and yard waste.

[Recyclable materials, as defined in § 11-1 of this article, and compostable yard waste may not be disposed of at the Quarantine Landfill.]

The following materials may not be disposed of at a landfill or an incinerator:

- (1) recyclable materials, as defined in § 1-1(d) {"Definitions Recyclable materials"} of this article; or
- (2) yard waste, as defined in § 1-1(e) {"Definitions Yard waste"} of this article.

Section 2. And be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect on October 1, 2025.
