A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning
Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation - Department of Transportation - \$2,000,000

FOR the purpose of providing a Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation in the amount of \$2,000,000 to the Department of Transportation - Service 690 (Complete Streets and Sustainable Transportation), to provide funding to support Charm City Circulator operations; and providing for a special effective date.

Recitals

The revenue appropriated by this Ordinance represents a grant from the Maryland Transit Administration in excess of the revenue relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2014.

That grant could not have been expected with reasonable certainty when the Ordinance of Estimates for Fiscal Year 2014 was formulated.

On June 11, 2014, the Board of Estimates recommended this appropriation to the City Council.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That \$2,000,000 shall be made available to the Department of Transportation - Service 690 (Complete Streets and Sustainable Transportation) as a Supplementary State Fund Operating Appropriation for Fiscal Year 2014, to provide funding to support Charm City Circulator operations. The source of revenue for this appropriation is a grant from Maryland Transit Administration in excess of the amount from this source that was relied on by the Board of Estimates in determining the tax levy required to balance the budget for Fiscal Year 2014.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
