CITY OF BALTIMORE COUNCIL BILL

A BILL ENTITLED

AN ORDINANCE concerning Sale of Property - 1749-1757 Gorsuch Avenue

FOR the purpose of authorizing the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to sell, at either public or private sale, all its interest in certain property known 1749-1757 Gorsuch Avenue (Block 4123, Lot 022) and no longer needed for public use; and providing for a special effective date.

BY authority of Article II - General Powers Section 15(c) Baltimore City Charter (1996 Edition)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That, in accordance with Article II § 15(c) of the City Charter, the Commissioner of Housing and Community Development may sell, at either public or private sale, all the interest of the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore in the property known as 1749-1757 Gorsuch Avenue (Block 4123, Lot 022), and more particularly described as follows:

The subject property, located in the Coldstream Homestead Montebello neighborhood, is a vacant building that was formerly a firehouse. The building was surplussed to the Department of Housing and Community Development when the firehouse was closed.

This property being no longer needed for public use.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That no deed may pass under this Ordinance unless the deed has been approved by the City Solicitor.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
