**Recordation and Transfer Taxes - Yield Excise Tax - Transactions Assessed**

For the purpose of amending which transactions are assessed the Yield Tax; and providing for a special effective date.

By repealing and re-ordaining, with amendments

**Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore,** That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

**Baltimore City Code**

**Article 28. Taxes**

**Subtitle 17.1. Recordation and Transfer Taxes - Yield Excise Tax**

**§ 17.1-2. Transactions assessed; Tax rate.**

(a) *Transactions assessed.*

The Yield Tax shall be assessed on those transactions whose value exceeds [\$1 million] \$750,000.00, as determined by Subtitles 16 and 17 of this article for the purposes of calculating the recordation and transfer taxes respectively.

**Section 2. And be it further ordained,** That this Ordinance takes effect on the date it is enacted.
