FOR the purpose of formally designating, as required by State law, the City's "primary enforcement unit" to receive certain records; conforming a definition to its State law counterpart; clarifying the need of scrap metal processors to comply with State licensing and regulatory provisions; authorizing the denial, suspension, or refusal to renew certain licenses for violation of certain State laws, rules, or regulations; providing for a special effective date; and generally relating to the licensing and regulation

of scrap metal processors.
