### AN ORDINANCE concerning Environmental Citations - Penalties

FOR the purpose of precluding the penalties for certain environmental offenses from creating liens on residential property; and generally relating to the enforcement of environmental citations. BY repealing and reordaining, with amendments

Article 1 - Mayor, City Council, and Municipal Agencies Section(s) 40-11(a) Baltimore City Code (Edition 2000)

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Baltimore City Code

Article 1. Mayor, City Council, and Municipal Agencies

Subtitle 40. Environmental Control Board

- § 4011. Enforcement of Board orders.
- (a) Penalty as debt and lien.
- (1) Any civil penalty imposed on a person by the Board, whether on hearing, on default, or otherwise:
- (I) [(1)] is a personal debt owed by that person to the City; and

## (II) [(2)] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, if the offense involves real

property owned by that person, creates a lien on that property in favor of the City.

# (2) PARAGRAPH (1)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO RESIDENTIAL REAL PROPERTY IF THE PENALTY IMPOSED IS FOR AN OFFENSE LISTED IN § 40-14(E)(4) {"ARTICLE 23. SANITATION"} OR § 40-14(E)(6A) {"PROPERTY MAINTENANCE CODE"} OF THIS SUBTITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date it is enacted.
