FOR the purpose of designating the Sellers Mansion, 801 Arlington Avenue, as a historical landmark.

SECTION 1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE, That the Laws of
Baltimore City read as follows:

Article 6. Historical and Architectural Preservation

Subtitle 12. Landmark List - 2000s

§ 12-45. SELLERS MANSION.

SELLERS MANSION, 801 NORTH ARLINGTON AVENUE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That the catchlines contained in this Ordinance are not law
and may not be considered to have been enacted as a part of this or any prior Ordinance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, That this Ordinance takes effect on the 30th day after the date
it is enacted.
