For the purpose of approving the budget estimated to be needed for the Baltimore City Board of School Commissioners for operating programs during Fiscal 2025; providing for certification of the approved budget to the State Superintendent of Schools; and providing for a special effective date.

Section 1. Be it resolved by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the following amounts or so much thereof as shall be sufficient are hereby approved from the amounts estimated to be available in the designated funds during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025.

Section 3. And be it further resolved, That the Capital Budget of Baltimore City Public School System consists of \$44,807,862 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025. Sources of these funds are \$19,000,000 from City of Baltimore General Obligation Bonds and \$25,807,862 from the State of Maryland.

Section 4. And be it further resolved, That when enacted, this Resolution shall be certified to the State Superintendent of Schools.

Section 5. And be it further resolved, That this Resolution takes effect July 1, 2024.
