For the purpose of revising the criteria for the Port Covington Area of Special Signage Control; and providing for a special effective date.

Section 1. Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, That the Laws of Baltimore City read as follows:

Article 32. Zoning

Title 17. Signs

Subtitle 5. Areas of Special Signage Control

§ 17-502. Applicability.

(a) *Districts.*

(1) An Area of Special Signage Control may be applied for in the C-1, C-1-E, C-1-VC, C-2, C-3, C-4, C

-5, IMU-1 or 2, OR, or TOD Zoning Districts.

- (2) The entire PC Zoning District[, as mapped on the adopted Zoning Map, as of June 5, 2017,] is designated an Area of Special Signage Control, unless the boundaries of the Area of Special Signage Control are otherwise amended per § 17-505.

Section 2. And be it further ordained, That this Ordinance takes effect the date it is enacted.
